“Sing to God a hymn of gladness!”


On this last weekend before the start of our Lenten season, we hear some simple and basic wisdom of life. *“The only thing you have to give is what you already have.”* This week’s gospel has a lot of great one-liners, but if we take each on its own terms, there’s a larger picture that shows us we can’t focus on others before we focus on bringing the best out of ourselves. We can’t guide a blind person until we, ourselves, can see. We can’t point out someone else’s faults until we have identified our own shortcomings, and we can’t give people the good fruit of our labors if we haven’t made any good fruit. Last week’s gospel was about how we treat others; this week is about how we treat ourselves. In these words, Jesus is inviting us to be honest and assess ourselves with a critical eye.

This coming Wednesday we begin our holy season of Lent. With all that has been happening over the past months and with the hope that things have turned the corner regarding to the pandemic our parish Lenten theme this year is *A Season of Fresh Hope!* Appropriately chosen as we all have the sincere hope that finally life will return to as normal as it possibly can. It is with this *“season of fresh hope”* that we enter this time of Lent – of sacrifice, prayer, devotion, and reflection. Please refer to the announcement in today’s bulletin about the regulations for fasting and abstaining from meat. Also available after Mass today are Lenten booklets for adults and children and Rice Bowls from Catholic Relief Services. The Rice Bowls will be part of our collection on Holy Thursday evening and may be returned then. May all of us embrace this time as we prepare for our celebration of Easter and the coming of spring! For with confidence and courage may this truly be...*A Season of Fresh Hope!*

Lent begins this coming Wednesday, March 2, 2022 with Ash Wednesday. Mass and the Distribution of Ashes will be at 8:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.



Lenten Regulations

- ❖ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of **Fast and Abstinence** (limit of one full meal and two smaller meals for persons 18 thru 59 years of age; no meat for persons 14 years and older).
- ❖ All Fridays during Lent are days of **Abstinence** (No meat for persons 14 years and older).
- ❖ There is no obligation to fast during the weekdays of Lent. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are encouraged.

Rice Bowls are available after Mass. Please take one home with you and use it as a tangible expression of putting into practice the Lenten traditions of *prayer, sacrifice, and almsgiving*. They may be returned on **Holy Thursday evening** or at any time during Holy Week.

Lenten Booklets for Adults and Children are available after Mass to be used as part of your Lenten prayer and reflection.

SUPER CASH BONANZA RAFFLE


