April 24, 2022 ~ Second Sunday of Easter



“Alleluia! Love is Alive!”

As we gather on this Second Sunday of our Easter season, we recall two dramatic scenes in this week’s gospel episode. Jesus’s friends are terrified and afraid of the religious authorities looking for them. While they are hiding, Jesus comes and stands in their midst telling them, *“Peace be with you.”* It is a rather surprising greeting considering that the disciples were exhausted. They had watched the brutal execution of one of their own, found his body stolen, and are now in hiding. They were likely at the peak of despair and the first thing Jesus offers them is *“peace.”* He doesn’t enter and immediately give an explanation, or an escape plan. He gives them *“peace.”* Perhaps our take-a-way from this lesson is that when our own anxiety is high and we do not understand a situation, instead of constantly seeking a solution, we can, as Jesus offers, focus our energy on finding *“peace”* in the midst of our turmoil. The second scene of this episode is the confession of faith by Thomas. This passage is generally considered the conclusion of John’s gospel account. From the very beginning of John’s version, we know that Jesus is the Son of God, the Word from the beginning. Today’s gospel puts that reality in a lived context. In his profession of faith, Thomas makes a clear and concise statement of belief: *“My Lord and my God!”* What an incredibly powerful “end” to the story! As we continue to experience the new life offered by the resurrection of the Lord may we also, through our words and actions, announce the same profession of faith as Thomas every day of our lives.

This weekend we bring to a close our PSR and Youth Ministry year and also celebrate First Communion with our second-grade students. I would like to offer my thanks to our entire staff of catechists for their dedication, care, and support shown to our children during this past year. I also offer my thanks and appreciation to our parents for their commitment to growing their child’s faith and understanding of the Lord in their life. It is the duty of parents to continually be a role model of truthful living according to the faith we profess. It is not always an easy job, but it remains one of the more vital and important responsibilities of parenthood. Even though our year is completed, I hope that all of us will continue our good faith and commitment to the church during the upcoming summer months.


