May 1, 2022 ~ Third Sunday of Easter



“Nothing now can ever part us from the love of Christ!”

From the readings last week and this week, we are able to watch Peter’s transformation from a timid and impulsive “sidekick” into the leader Jesus always knew he would be. Peter has fumbled his way through the gospel since we met him, and Jesus never stopped drawing him close. When Peter recognizes Jesus, he is so filled with excitement that he jumps off the side of the boat and swims to Jesus. He is overseeing the net full of fish, but instead of checking in with his colleagues, he dives into the sea to get to his friend as



fast as possible. There is an unfettered humanity about Peter and in his desire to be close to the Lord in whatever way he can. It is this pure, almost childlike desire for the goodness of Jesus that becomes the face of the church on earth. Today Jesus tells the disciples, *“if you love me, feed my lambs, tend my sheep.”* These words reiterate the concrete realities of following the Lord. We do not live in isolation from the rest of the world, or as a practice of individualism. Rather, our relationship with Jesus compels us to be the heart, voice, and hands of Christ for others. Like he does so often throughout the gospel, Jesus shows by example how we are to treat others. By his care for the catch of fish and his invitation to breakfast the disciples recognize and realize this how they are to care for others. As we seek to imitate Christ, we have this same responsibility. As this season of Easter continues to unfold in our midst may we recognize our call to discipleship and embrace it with the same enthusiasm and effort that the disciples did of long ago.



This is just **19** less meals than the last time we had a full year (2019) including in-person dining. The total income this year was \$58,118.00. 
