Last week we heard John the Baptist refer to the baptism of Jesus by proclaiming him the "Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world." Today's gospel brings us to the beginning of Jesus's public ministry. Jesus calls the disciples in pairs – a powerful reminder that discipleship happens in community. Each of us brings particular gifts, but those gifts are not meant to be shared in isolation. Christ calls each of us to follow him in communion with other believers just as he did with Simon, Andrew, James, and John. Together we further Christ's work of proclaiming the gospel message through our constant commitment to discipleship and service to one another.



This weekend we celebrate the "Sunday of the Word of God." A few years ago, Pope Francis established the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time to be observed as the "Sunday of the Word of God." His initiative seeks to continually foster the Church's love of Sacred Scripture strengthening efforts in its catechesis evangelization. In our life of faith, there are many opportunities that connect and immerse us in the message of Sacred Scripture. By focusing on the role of the Word of God in prayer, catechesis, and liturgy we allow "the word of Christ to dwell in us richly" (Col. 3:16), not just on Sunday but in every moment of life. Let us joyfully celebrate "Word of God Sunday" this weekend never forgetting the powerful presence of Sacred Scripture in our lives.

We welcome Father Ed Noga to our parish this weekend. I am grateful for his kindness and generosity in being at our parish.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK NEXT WEEKEND

The Anointing of the Sick will be celebrated at all Masses next weekend January 28-29, 2023. We believe that Christ acts in and through his Body- the Church- to exercise his healing power in our world today, much the same as when he walked the streets of the earth. We pray for total healing – physical, emotional, and spiritual – of the person through this sacrament. Those who should be anointed include:

- ◆ The sick those who have an illness that could become serious;
- ◆ Senior Citizens because of age;
- Those who are to undergo surgery because of serious illness:
- Children who are ill, whose illness could become serious;
- ◆ Those who have been previously anointed, but whose sickness continues, or who have been considered in a new danger from sickness.

By the anointing of the sick, the whole person is helped through the grace of the Holy Spirit. This sacrament enables us to participate, in a deeper way, in the Paschal Mystery, and so to live and accept our life circumstances in the light of the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Please encourage those in need of healing to receive this sacrament and let us all continue to pray for those who suffer in any way, that God will manifest His healing power upon them.
