# "Sing a joyful song to the Lord!"

Today's gospel reading continues the theme introduced last week as Jesus is preparing his disciples to live without him for a time, or at least without the bodily presence they have come to know and which will depart earth at the ascension. This week adds a foreshadowing of the upcoming Pentecost feast; Jesus's presence will remain in the Holy Spirit, who will accompany the disciples and the church beyond their lifetime in their remaining work on earth. For us, too, the Holy Spirit is a promised companion, providing continuity with these earliest of Jesus's followers. Like the disciples, we are not left alone in the struggle. In today's gospel Jesus assures us that God's Spirit "remains with you and will be in you." There have always been and will always be struggles that accompany



a life of faith, and we might wonder why Jesus does not make his presence more visible and obvious to us and to those who would criticize us. But God is not about "winning" in the way we would sometimes choose; the "win" here is not that we will never struggle or suffer but that we will never be left alone in our struggles. As we approach the celebration of Pentecost, let us be ever more mindful of the Spirit's lasting presence in our lives.

On this Mother's Day weekend we congratulate, thank, and honor all those who are mothers, grandmothers, stepmothers, godmothers and all who take care of, nurture and foster life. We remain ever grateful to our mothers for their care and concern shown to us and we remember in a special way all our mothers who have embraced eternal life. *Happy Mother's Day to All!*


