Dear Parish Community of St. William,

Happy Corpus Christi Sunday! Today's solemnity draws our attention to an important movement in our national Church. For the last year, we have been celebrating the Eucharistic Revival in the United States and this Sunday is intended to focus this movement within each parish community. For us, this means we are invited to renew our appreciation for the Eucharist we celebrate every Sunday. In the face of a very confusing world, we see that there is no way for us to make sense of things on our own. The Eucharist draws our attention to a mystery which can give us a lens for understanding our world.

A great part of the mystery of the Eucharist is that it means thanksgiving. I invite you to take this next year of the Eucharistic revival to reflect on what the significance of thanksgiving is in the Church. To get you started, I recommend you take some time to reread the Last Supper in which Jesus celebrated the first Eucharist with His disciples. Jesus laid down His life for you on the cross, so that any sins or circumstances separating you from God would be removed. Not only did Jesus endure torture and death for you, He was grateful to do this for you. Such

love truly moves the heart when you realize that this love is specifically for you. Every time you receive the Eucharist, Jesus is saying, "Thank you for celebrating My sacrifice and My love for you."

Take this another step further and remember that when you receive the Eucharist, you have the opportunity to join in Jesus' sacrifice of thanksgiving. Think of the people in your life for whom you are grateful to serve. So many times, it is in ministering to others that we receive the most joy and fulfillment. Jesus celebrates the same joy and fulfillment in His death and resurrection for us. This is but a glimpse into the beauty we celebrate in the Eucharist. I pray that in this next year, you will remain attentive to the voice of the Church as she calls us to a deeper devotion to the Eucharist. A deeper celebration of the source and summit of our faith will keep us rooted in the hope which no despair can overcome.





LITURGY / MUSIC MINISTRY


