THE SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, this week, our Church celebrated the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is one of the most significant SATURDAY feasts in honor of Our Lady, and it commemorates her being taken up, body and soul, into Heaven. *The Belief* The Assumption is a declaration of faith in the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Our Lady, having completed her earthly life, was assumed into Heaven. This dogma, infallibly defined by Pope Pius XII in 1950, is rooted in both Sacred Scripture and Tradition. Mary's Assumption prefigures our own resurrection and eternal union with God. *The Significance* The Assumption serves as a profound reminder of the special role that Mary plays in the story of salvation. As the Mother of God, she was preserved from the stain of original sin from the moment of her conception, and at the end of her earthly life, she was assumed into Heaven. This feast offers us hope that those who follow Christ and seek to live in accordance with His teachings will be welcomed into the eternal joy of Heaven. Reflect and Celebrate As we celebrate this feast, let us take



a moment to reflect on the virtues of the Blessed Virgin Mary - her humility, obedience, and undying love for God. May her Assumption be an inspiration for us to live our lives in dedication to Christ, with the hope of one day joining Him and all the saints in Heaven. May

the grace and peace of Our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.
