OCTOBER 1, 2023 THE TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In this parable, Jesus tells the story of a father who asks his two sons to work in the vineyard. The first son initially refuses but later goes, while the second son says he will go but doesn't. Jesus uses this story to point out the hypocrisy of the religious leaders of His day, who said they followed God SATURDAY but did not do His will, in contrast to tax collectors and prostitutes who repented and genuinely followed God. Reflection: The Parable of the Two Sons challenges us to examine the integrity of our words and actions. It reminds us that it's not enough to merely speak of faith or to outwardly SUNDAY conform to religious practices. Genuine faith involves a heart that is willing to act on God's will, even if initially reluctant. This Gospel passage prompts



self-examination: Are we people who merely say 'yes' with our lips but 'no' with WEEKDAYS our actions? Or do we strive to align our words with our deeds in service to God? The message here is clear: it's not about the promises we make, but about the actions we take in the name of faith.

### LITTLE ROCK SCRIPTURE STUDY


