Dear Friends: "We know ourselves as we think of ourselves." Others see us differently. One of the goals of personal and spiritual growth is to know who we are, as we are, as we are known, and to make sure there is truth between the two. You know me as a pastor. I have been educated and credentialed for this job. Is it for self or for God? With such a role comes both biblical and social or "cultural" expectations.

Yet, what about you? How does the public person and the private person that you are mesh? Do they? And why does it matter. It matters to God. The Lord has condemned hypocrisy. And yet hypocrisy is part of the fallen human condition. Matthew 23:1-12 is about the hypocrisy of the religious leaders of Israel. Their dress, their actions, their teaching, their fancy titles and even their very presence is a pretense, offensive to God and imprisoning for those who follow them. Jesus uses this example to exalt the virtue of humility. The Christian virtue of humility is a virtue most to be desired because it is the opposite of pride. It is one of the sacred WEEKDAYS gates into the City of Eternal Life.
