NOVEMBER 5, 2023 THE THIRTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends: In turning the page to November, we begin to anticipate the end of the year as the leaves have turned from brightly colorful to a million shades of brown and the world outside slowly readies itself for the slumber of winter. In the few weeks left before Advent, our scripture readings will echo this theme of the "end times." Today's parable of the ten virgins provides us an opportunity to think about the second coming of Christ and the time when we will meet the Lord at the end of our own lives.

Through the story of ten virgins, this parable is meant to tell us that we do not know when the Lord's coming is, so we must stay vigilant. Will we be prepared SUNDAY when the time has come? It also shows that not everyone will be allowed into the Kingdom of Heaven. The five virgins who were prepared at the time of the



bridegroom's arrival were welcomed into the wedding. The five who were not ready in time were left behind the closed door and not allowed entry. It was too late for them. This is why we must be ready at any hour! When the Lord comes, there will not be time to right your wrongs. We must use our time now to prepare for what is to come.

Life throws so many unexpected things at us, but it is reassuring to know that the Lord will return and that we can prepare for his arrival by living out our best lives as Christians.


