In this weeks' reading we find that Jesus is calling on us to "wake" up and smell the roses, or the coffee, or the kolachi that was baked this past Wednesday. No matter what it is that we wake up and smell, the intent is the same...Jesus wants SATURDAY us to be ready for what is coming. On this first Sunday in Advent, we must be awake to the challenges of this world, the injustices of what is happening around us, and the basic needs of those less fortunate in our communities. We cannot be 'gonna" people. Being awake means that you are ready for action when you see need. Jesus doesn't care if you were "gonna" feed the starving child...you only get credit for the child you actually fed. Responding to Jesus' call to action is not a passive response but a response that demands immediate action. You must get up and do something. The Gospel lets us know that each day we need to start anew



with a determination to build a better world and be part of a larger solution. If you have always been "gonna" do it, well here is your sign to start now. How we answer the call to action and live a life that has awakened, is part of who we are and how we will celebrate the coming of the Lord's birth in the coming weeks.

As we enter the season of Advent, we have much to be thankful for and much to prepare for to celebrate the birth of Jesus. I hope that many of you will join us this Tuesday evening, December 5

at 7:00 p.m. for our special Advent Evening Prayer of Lessons and Carols. This reflective prayer of scripture and song helps set the tone for these weeks before Christmas and provides an opportunity for all of us to wait together for the coming of Christ.
